The longest portion of the time was taken up with selecting the appropriate photo to be submitted.

The website indicated a 4 to 6 week waiting period. Well it took 7 working days to have the sheets delivery by regular post. Not bad at all.

Size, power and speed, the majestic blue whale (*Balænoptera musculus*), king of the animal kingdom, has it all. Weighing in at between 80 and 180 metric tonnes and reaching lengths of more than 30 m, our planet has never—even in the age of dinosaurs—seen another creature this big. It can travel at speeds of 33 km/hr, accelerating to 48 km/hr when chased, making it among the fastest whale species.



This fascinating giant of the deep is also unmatched in the projection of its voice, emitting low-frequency sounds that can travel hundreds of miles (and possibly entire oceans) under water. Yet despite its outstanding stature and might, sightings of the elusive blue whale are very rare—another reason why it has fascinated us

since the dawn of time.

Canada is home to two populations of the blue whale. The Atlantic population roams the waters off eastern Canada, along the north shore of the Gulf of St. Lawrence in eastern Nova Scotia, the south coast of Newfoundland, and in the Davis Strait between Baffin Island and Greenland. Pacific populations are located off Canada's West Coast.

The stamp is the newest addition to our popular Canadian Wildlife series, which includes a grizzly bear (\$8, 1997), a loon (\$1, 1998), a polar bear (\$2, 1998) a moose (\$5, 2003), a white-tailed deer (\$1, 2005), an Atlantic walrus (\$1, 2005), a Peregrine falcon (\$2, 2005) and a Sable Island horse (\$2, 2005).

Like the wildlife definitives that preceded it, this stamp was produced using a combination of three printing techniques: intaglio (for the whale in the foreground) and offset lithography (for the colours in the background). Alain Leduc, Manager of Stamp Design and Production at Canada Post, elaborates, "The intaglio process (which was used to produce Canada's first postage stamp) was recently reinvented using a new, state-of-the-art laser engraving technology."

The image of the whale is the work of master engraver Jorge Peral and was based on an illustration by Suzanne Duranceau.

"This is both the biggest stamp and highest stamp denomination Canada Post has ever produced," notes Leduc. "We thought this made a fitting tribute to the largest creature in the animal kingdom." He explains that he looked to prior issues in the Canadian Wildlife series to determine the size. "Since the largest stamp before it was the grizzly bear, we decided to double its length."

"Due to the stamp's high value, we wanted to introduce as many security features as possible in order to prevent fraud," says Leduc. Though determined to keep some of these features secret, he notes that a few were created using intaglio and invisible "tagging" inks. For example, microtype was used to write the Latin name for blue whale—a feature that is impossible to reproduce by any other means than intaglio. Additionally, a large cluster of krill (the whale's food of choice), along with a diver, were introduced using tagging inks. "Looking at these stamps with a black light introduces a whole new dimension to the design."

#### A NIGHT AT THE MOVIES

Bill Pooley provided the group with a very entertaining visual about movies and actors on stamps at the October 21<sup>st</sup> meeting.



Along with pop and popcorn, Bill provided an exhibit of a miniature show hall and drive in theatre.

Also included was an in-depth quiz on such things as name the four Marx Brothers (Harpo, Zeppo, Chico, Groucho, and Gummo); who wrote King Kong? Merian C. Cooper; the author of Force 10 from Navarone? Alistair MacLean.; etc.

It was an entertaining evening.

# Nordic Notes by John Salmi

## Danish or Faroese Nobel Laureate.

Niels Ryberg Finsen was born in Tórshavn in the Faroe Islands on December 15, 1860 to Hannes Steingrim Finsen and Johanne Frøman. Both of his parents were born and raised in Iceland but his father was made Landfoged of the Faroe Islands in 1858 at which time he relocated his family..

He began his schooling at a Danish boarding school Herlufsholm but due to poor grades, transferred to his father's old school, Lærði skólinn in Reykjavik in 1876.

His grades improved to the point, that in 1882, Niels Finsen moved to Copenhagen to study medicine at the University of Copenhagen. He graduated in 1890 and for 3 years was a prosector of anatomy at the university.

He began his scientific studies on his theory that wavelengths of light can have beneficial medical effects. In 1896 the Finsen Institute was founded with Niels Finsen as its director.

In 1898, Finsen received a full professorship and in 1899 he became a Knight of the Order of Danneborg.

His later works would include studying the effects of salt in the diet. In 1903 he became the first Danish Nobel laureate when he was awarded the Nobel Prize in Medicine and Physiology "in recognition of his contribution to the treatment of diseases, especially lupus vulgaris, with concentrated light radiation, whereby he opened a new avenue for medical science."

Tragically, Niels Finsen died on September 24, 1904 at the age of 43 from a long term heart condition.



Four stamps were issued to commemorate his achievements. The stamp to the left was issued as part of the Europa series by the Faroes and the stamps below by Denmark, on the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his birth and by Sweden in 1963 which honoured the 1903 Nobel Laureates, SA Arrhenius in Chemistry, NR Finsen for medicine and BM Björnson for literature.



In 2003, Denmark issued a stamp commemorating the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first Nobel prize winner from that country. The stamp features the portrait of Niels Finsen and a statue that was erected in Copenhagen as a memorial to his work in 1908. The statue was sculpted by Rudolph Tegner and is named Mod Iyset ( Towards the Light ).

In the June issue of the Scandinavian Contact, a quarterly journal of the UK Scandinavian Philatelic Society, a 1905 Danish registered cover addressed to Naples features the cinderella stamp at the top of this column which helps date the issue. The 10 øre denomination indicates it was used to raise funds but does not answer the question who issued it or how the funds raised were to be used. More research will be required.

## When does being Green make you Blue?

The Post Green semi-postal stamp to the left was issued by Finland on May 4, 2010. The stamp was designed to help send messages carbon-neutrally. The paper was made of 100% recyclable paper. No bleaching or clarifying agents were used on it and no lacquer or gloss was added to the finish. The fresh green tone was made possible by using water-soluble printing ink which might make some collectors blue if they didn't realize that when separating stamp from paper. The surcharge of .05€ will be used to

## Commonwealth Games 2010 Stamps

In honor of the XIX Commonwealth Games India Post has issued a series of commemorative stamps.

The Games are being held in Delhi from 3 to 14 October 2010. The opening ceremony took place at the Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium, the main stadium of the event. This marks the first time the Commonwealth Games have been held in India and the second time the event has been held in Asia (after the 1998 Games in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia).



The event was first held in 1930 under the title of the British Empire Games in Hamilton, Ontario, Canada. The event was renamed as the British Empire and Commonwealth Games in 1954, the British Commonwealth Games in 1970, and gained its current title in 1978. There are currently 54 members of the Commonwealth of Nations, and 71 teams participate in the Games.

The 2010 Commonwealth Games has been held in Delhi, India.

The stamp was designed by Stephen Perera

The logo of the Games is inspired by the Chakra, the national symbol of freedom, unity and power. Spiralling upwards, it depicts the growth of India into a proud, vibrant nation.

The official mascot for the 2010 Commonwealth Games is Shera, an anthropomorphized tiger.

## Commonwealth Games - New Gibraltar Issue

Gibraltar Post has issued a stamp in honour of the XIX Commonwealth Games.



The Commonwealth Games is an international, multi-sport event involving thousands of elite athletes from members of the Commonwealth of Nations.

## Oktoberfest

The tradition of annual celebration of Oktoberfest goes back to 12th of October 1810 when the wedding of Crown Prince Ludwig, later King Ludwig I and Princess Therese of Saxony-Hildburghausen was held in Munich. The official celebrations of the wedding lasted five days. It consisted of National Guard parade, illuminations and music, food and drink, trumpets and drums - a big party took place in the center of Munich.



The following year it was decided to repeat the celebration at the same time. Today the Bavarian Oktoberfest is the largest folk festival in the world. Munich beer and hospitality, high tech rides and nostalgic carnival attractions invite everybody to join the celebration.

## Luciano Pavarotti

The Republic of San Marino issued a postage stamp to commemorate the 75th anniversary of Luciano Pavarotti's birth. He was born in Modena on the 12th October, 1935, revealed his vocal talent at a very early age, passing hours in front of the record player and ransacking his father's record collection, an amateur tenor.



## The First Qualified Woman Pilot

France Post has issued a stamp to honour Raymonde de Laroche

(22 August 1882 - 18 July 1919). Born Elise Raymonde Deroche, she was the first woman in the world to receive an airplane pilot's license. On October 22nd 1909 at Chalons, she made her first solo flight of 300 yards in a Voisin biplane. "It is infinitely more charming than motoring" she said. A plane crash in 1910 (in which she received serious injuries) and a car crash in 1912 failed to deter her. After many unsuccessful attempts to join the French Air Force she died in a plane crash in 1919.



## Confucius

China Post has issued a new set of three special stamps depicting the Temple of Confucius and the Tomb of Confucius.

The largest and oldest Temple of Confucius is found in Confucius's hometown, present-day Qufu in Shandong Province. It was established in 478 BC, one year after Confucius's death, at the order of the Duke Ai of the State of Lu, who commanded that the Confucian residence should be used to worship and offer sacrifice to Confucius. The temple was expanded repeatedly over a period of more than 2,000 years until it became the huge complex currently standing.
